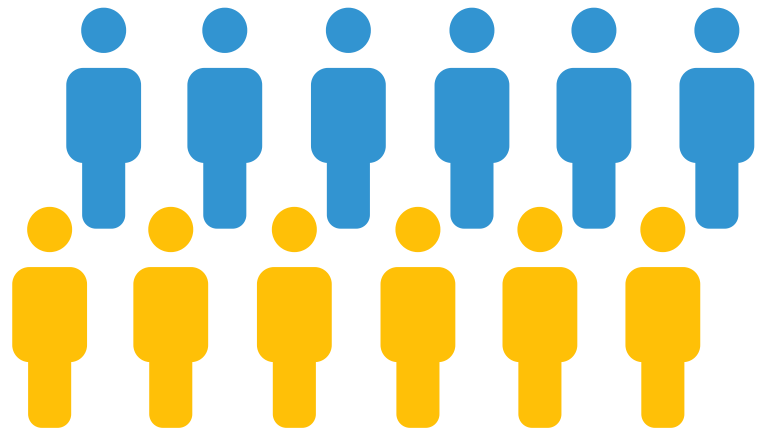

OUR TEAM

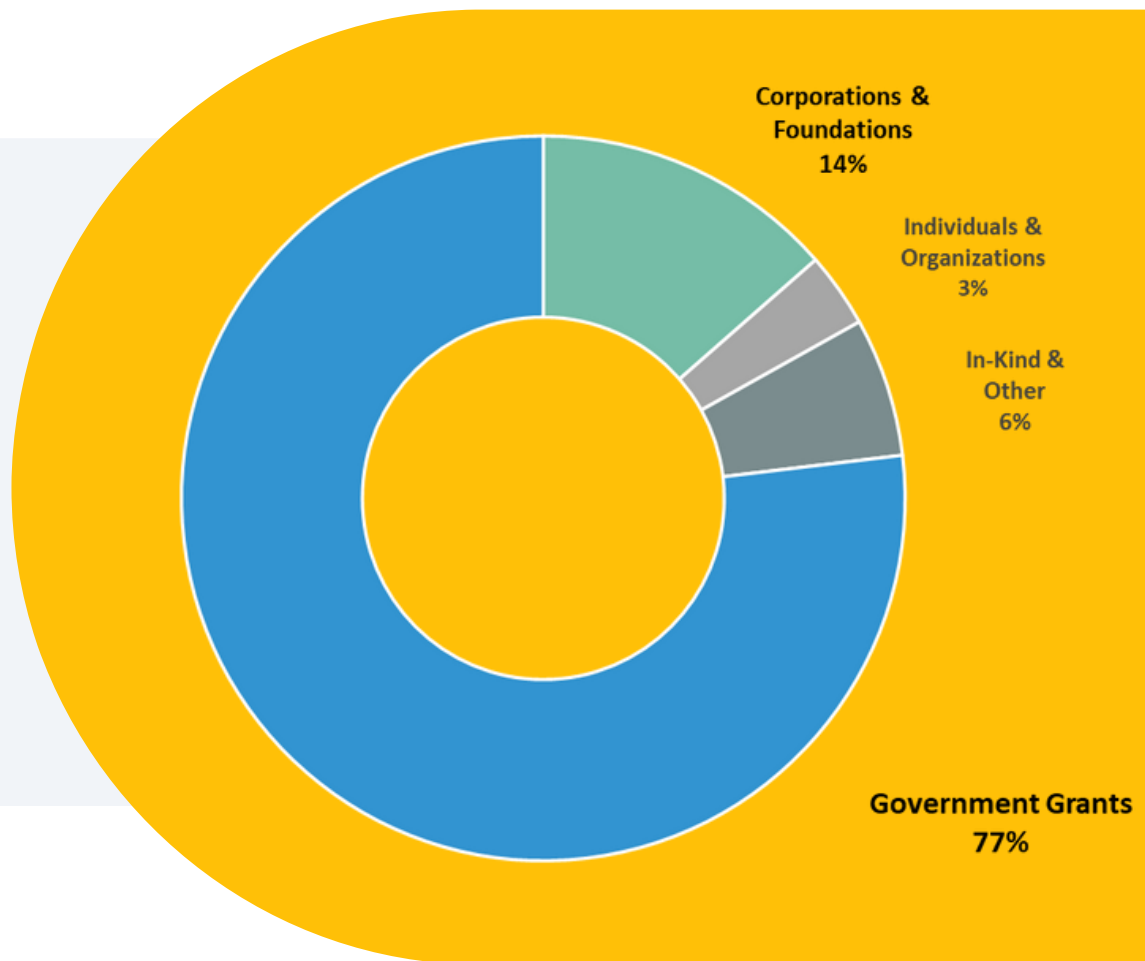


The staff at Crisis House works tirelessly to provide person-centered, trauma-informed care to our clients.

The Board of Directors is a dynamic group of community leaders focused on creating substantive improvements in our communities.

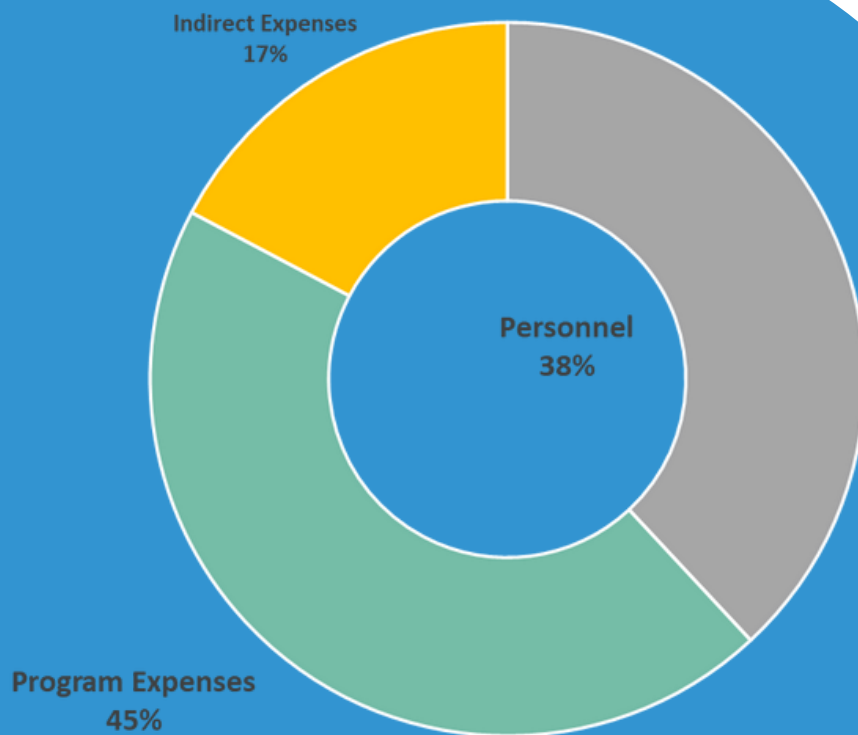


OUR REVENUE

OUR PROGRAMS

Homeless Services



Crisis House's Homeless Outreach Team and Project Homeless Connect provide authentic, practical services to individuals experiencing homelessness to help support their exit from homelessness.

Our Homeless Outreach Team has connected over 300 individuals experiencing homelessness with the resources and support they need.

In addition, the one-day Project Homeless Connect provided 242 individuals experiencing homelessness with over 40 vendors offering services including rehabilitation, employment assistance, mental health services, legal services, clothing, and pet vaccinations.



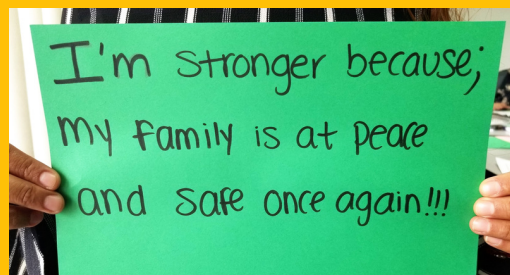
OUR PROGRAMS

Domestic Violence Services



Crisis House's Domestic Violence services assists individuals and families fleeing domestic violence, providing individual and group counseling, case management, health care, food, and other crucial support services. Survivors learn how to form non-violent family units, identify red flags in toxic relationships, provide emotional support to other survivors, rebuild self-esteem, and set healthy boundaries.

Crisis House received 3,155 crisis calls over the course of the year. We were able to serve 5,059 individuals with resources and support. Of those, close to 400 individuals fleeing domestic violence were provided with confidential, safe housing and the support they needed to start a secure, renewed life.



OUR PROGRAMS

Camp HOPE



Camp HOPE America – San Diego helps youth exposed to trauma and domestic violence find pathways to hope and healing through an innovative camping and year-round mentoring program. Our team at Crisis House is passionate about fostering a safe, hope-driven community for campers and their families through coordinating a week of camp, followed by monthly activities exposing youth to different areas of interest such as nature, arts, and STEM to spark career goals and develop pathways to achieve those goals.

In 2023, Crisis House provided services to nearly 100 youth who have been exposed to domestic violence.
